KY VALOR (Veterans Accelerated Licensure Occupational Recruitment)

Helps veterans and transitioning service members use their military experience to enter civilian careers through 44 accelerated pathways into 55 licensed/certified occupations. Covers more than 180 Military Occupational Specialties. Offers one-on-one support: they'll help you set up a profile, connect with employers, and navigate licensing or certification. Also supports military spouses in finding employment.
