Kentucky's Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV)

The Kentucky DMV handles driver licensing and motor vehicle services. This includes issuing and renewing driver's licenses (including REAL ID), state ID cards, and commercial driver's licenses (CDLs); testing; registering and titling vehicles, boats, and campers; and other related services.
